- 1. Examinations for each part and each section of Parts IV and V may be taken separately, and a Certificate of Proficiency issued for the individual parts or sections passed.
- 2. The Companion desiring to be examined as to his proficiency shall make request to either the Regional Deputy Grand Lecturer, the Grand Lecturer, or local Companions using the ritual.
- 3. As soon as possible, there shall be appointed a committee consisting of not less than two (2) nor more than three (3) certified companions.
- 4. The examination shall be held in one continuous session. No one shall be admitted to the examination room except the Applicant and the Committee without the express approval of the Applicant.
- 5. The Applicant shall give from memory, the part or section on which he is being examined in accordance with the ritual as prescribed by the Grand Chapter Royal Arch Masons of the State of Missouri.
- 6. If, in the opinion of the Examining Committee, the part or section has been given in an acceptable manner, the Chairman of the Examining Committee shall promptly notify the Grand Lecturer, who will issue a Certificate of Proficiency good for a period of three (3) years, bearing the signature of the Grand Secretary and the Chairman of the Ritual Committee.
